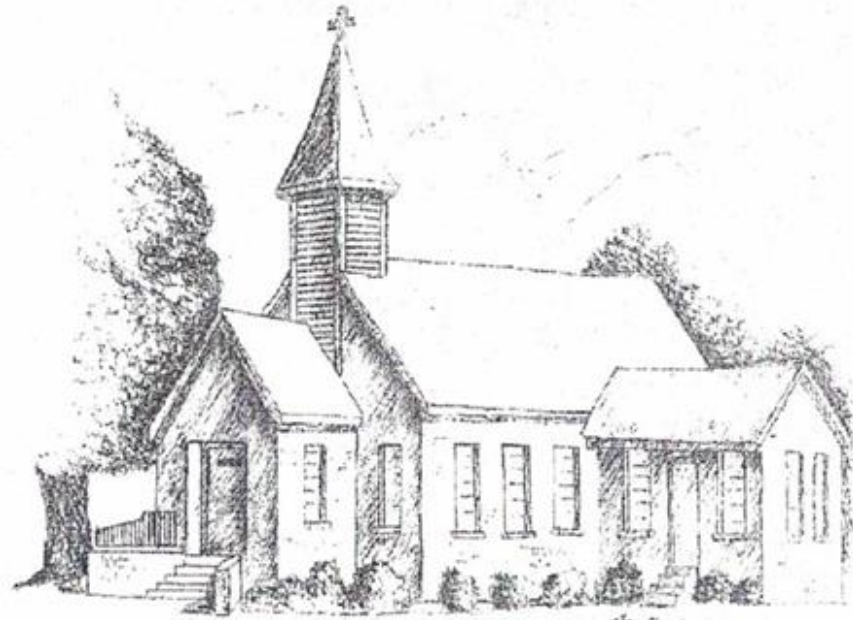

**The only Redeemer of God's elect is the Lord Jesus Christ,<sup>[a]</sup> who, being the eternal Son of God<sup>[b]</sup> became man,<sup>[c]</sup> and so was and continues to be God and man, in two distinct natures and one person for ever.<sup>[d]</sup>**
