A. 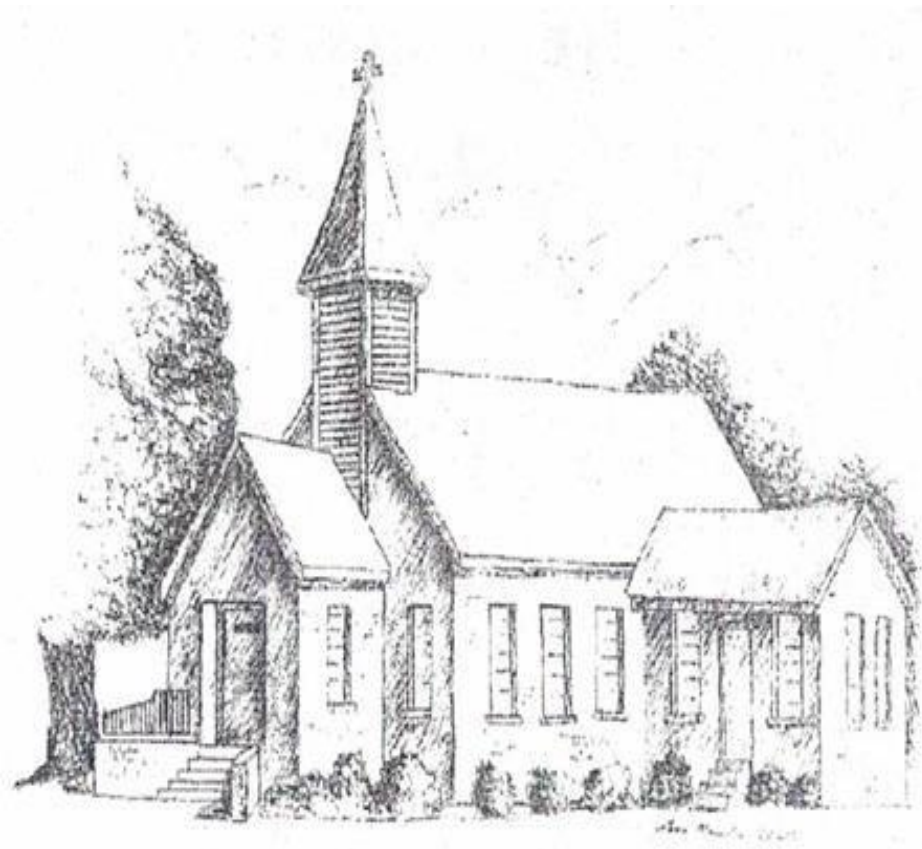
