

CALL TO WORSHIP

Matthew 21

- 1 Now Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, "Go into the village in front of you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Bring them to me.
- **3** If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord needs them,' and he will send them at once."
- 4 This took place to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet, saying,
- 5 ¶ "Say to the daughter of Zion, 'Behold, your king is coming to you, humble, and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden."
- **6** ¶ The disciples went and did as Jesus had directed them.
- 7 They brought the donkey and the colt and put on them their cloaks, and he sat on them.
- **8** Most of the crowd spread their cloaks on the road, & others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road.
- **9** And the crowds that went before him & followed him were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"
- **10** And when he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred up, saying, "Who is this?"
- 11 And the crowds said, "This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth of Galilee."
