

Q. 16. Did all mankind fall in Adam's first disobedience?

A: Since the covenant of life was made with Adam^[a] for his descendants as well as for himself, all mankind descending from him in the ordinary manner, sinned in him, and fell with him in his first transgression.^[b]

O. 18. What is the sinfulness of that state into which man fell?

A: The sinfulness of the state into which man fell includes the guilt of Adam's first sin, [a] the lack of the righteousness[b] which he had at first, and the corruption of every part of his nature, [c] which is commonly called Original Sin; together with all actual sins which flow from it. [d]

Q. 19. What misery did the fall bring upon mankind?
